Confession of Sin and Assurance of Pardon

Leader: The prophet Isaiah writes, "The earth lies defiled under its inhabitants; for they have transgressed the laws, violated the statutes, broken the everlasting covenant."
[Isaiah 24:5]

Let us confess our sins together.

All: God, the Father of Mercies, we beseech you to hear the prayers of your Church, for which our Lord Jesus Christ was content to be betrayed, and given up into the hands of wicked men, and to suffer death upon the cross. Forgive our sins because of his sacrifice, and according to your new covenant, which he sealed there with his blood, put your laws into all our hearts, and write them in our minds. Remember our sins and iniquities no more, for the sake of him, who when he had offered one sacrifice for sin, forever sat down at your right hand, and now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forevermore. Amen.

Leader: In this time of silent confession, Lord, we bring to you our particular sins.

[Silent confession]

Leader: If you are trusting in Christ, receive this assurance of pardon from God's Word.

Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.

Pastoral Prayer

*** Affirmation of Faith: Apostles' Creed**

Leader: Christian, what do you believe?

All: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell.* The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
